

Classifying College Football Teams from 1882 to 1972, Revisited

This study revisits the article *Classifying College Football Teams from 1882 to 1972 with a Naïve Bayesian Classifier* presented with the March 2013 edition of *The College Football Historian*. Since its publication, the naïve Bayesian classifier has been modified extensively to produce better results. However, this study uses a different approach to incorporate principles of network analysis by exploring a Bayesian version of the TrustRank algorithm to develop an initial list of classifications for college football teams from 1882 to 1972. This initial list is further refined using a “Komondor” algorithm developed specifically for this study.

Methodology

The last two decades have seen a marked increase in network analysis with efforts primarily aimed at improving the efficacy of internet search engines. PageRank, developed by and named for Google co-founder Larry Page, is one of the most popular algorithms for network analysis and essentially models a “random surfer” who moves from one webpage to another by randomly following links. Researchers at Stanford and Yahoo! subsequently developed a variation of PageRank titled TrustRank. TrustRank requires a content expert, referred to as an *oracle*, to assess a level of *trust* for an initial *seed set* of webpages. Once assessed and assigned to each webpage in the seed set, trust is then *propagated* through the network from the seed set to other webpages. Particular attention is paid to the mechanisms involved in *trust attenuation* so that webpages closer to the seed set accumulate a larger level of trust than those further away. Once propagation is complete, webpages can then be ordered according to their accumulated trust and a *threshold* established. Webpages above the threshold (more closely associated with the seed set) are considered trustworthy in content while ones that fall below the threshold (further from the seed set) might be considered suspect.

This study incorporates a Bayesian approach into TrustRank to determine college football teams that should be considered Division I, Division II, and Division III from 1882 to 1972. The oracle function is provided by utilizing two contemporary sources, namely All-America selections from 1882 to 1945 and the NCAA’s own identification of “Major” teams from 1946 to 1972. Using this data, a raw level of “Division I trust” was developed for each team. Once the Division I trust for each team was calculated, the total Division I trust was normalized to 1.00 for each season, or 91.00 for the entire set of 91 seasons from 1882 to 1972.

Table 1 shows the normalized Division I trust for teams from the 1936 season. These teams are considered part of the overall seed set for Division I trust.

Once the Division I trust for each season is calculated, it is then propagated through the network via games, conference affiliations, and season to season instances of each team, similar to links from one webpage to another. Intuitively trust should diminish as it propagates through the network so that teams closer to the seed set accumulate a larger amount of trust than those further from the seed set. To achieve trust attenuation, the mechanisms of retention, splitting, and accumulation are used.

The retention mechanism allows each team to retain a certain level of its initial Division I trust. Retention is accomplished through use of the “lazy walker” model, where each team retains half of its Division I trust while the other half is propagated among all of its opponents, conference affiliations, and previous and subsequent instances.

As an example, Table 1 shows 1936 Minnesota has an initial Division I trust of 0.067235. Half of its initial trust ($0.067235 / 2 = 0.0336175$) is retained by 1936 Minnesota while the remaining half (0.0336175) is propagated among its eight opponents, nine affiliated conference members, and the 1935 and 1937 instances of

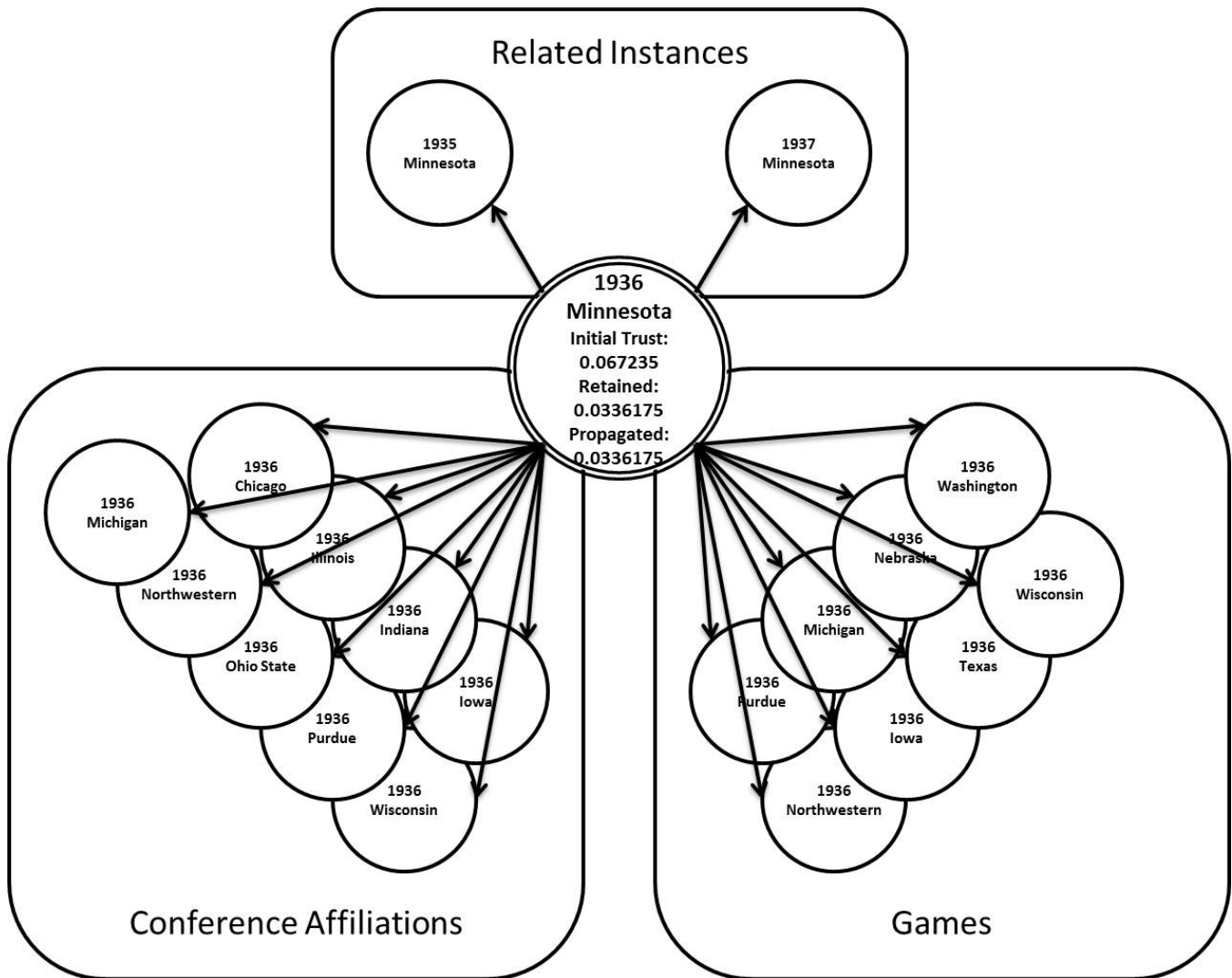


Figure 1 Trust propagation for 1936 Minnesota

Minnesota’s teams as illustrated in Figure 1. Note that under this construct conference opponents are counted twice, once during consideration of a team’s conference affiliations and once again during consideration of a team’s opponents.

The splitting mechanism determines how the trust will be apportioned among the outgoing links. Under the basic TrustRank algorithm, trust is apportioned equally to each recipient. In 1936 Minnesota’s example, each link would receive an equal portion of 1936 Minnesota’s Division I trust ($0.0336175 / 19 = 0.001769$). Again, 1936 Minnesota’s conference opponents would receive the amount twice, once during consideration of its conference affiliations and once again during consideration of its opponents.

However, Division I teams do not always play games against Division I opponents, do not always share conference affiliations with Division I teams, and are not always Division I in previous or subsequent seasons. For example, while Division I teams normally play Division I opponents, they occasionally play Division II or Division III opponents. Considering the interactions with other divisions adds additional complexity to TrustRank since teams must now be tracked for Division I trust, Division II trust, and Division III trust, with the amount of trust propagated between opponents, conference affiliations, and instances being proportional to the probability that the recipient is of the respective divisions.

Using the 1973 to 1977 seasons to establish a training set, a profile can be built and a Bayesian adjustment can be applied to each link. Teams in the training set were identified as Division I, Division II, and Division III based on their NCAA and NAIA classifications while NAIA Division I teams were identified as Division II and NAIA Division II teams were identified as Division III. All other teams in the training set were identified as Division III. Using this data, a profile of the interactions between each division can be built that will be used to apportion the propagation of trust.

From 1973 to 1977, Division I teams hosted 3,597 games. Of those, 3,249 were against other Division I teams, 328 were against Division II teams, 20 were against Division III teams, and none were against “unlisted” teams (i.e., junior varsity teams, high schools, athletic clubs, etc.). A standard sample correction of one has been added to each category so that no category has the possibility of never existing, giving the results in Table 2.

Using the game between 1936 Minnesota and 1936 Texas as an example, 1936 Minnesota was the home team and won by 28 points. Assuming 1936 Minnesota is a Division I team and using the profile, the likelihood of 1936 Texas being Division I, Division II, or Division III can be calculated.

Because 1936 Texas is a known to be a listed team, the unlisted column can be safely ignored. In total, with the standard sample correction and ignoring the unlisted column, Division I teams played $3,250 + 329 + 21 = 3,600$ games. Assuming 1936 Minnesota was a Division I team and knowing the game was a home game, 1936 Texas has a $3,250 / 3,600 = 0.9028$ likelihood of being Division I, a $329 / 3,600 = 0.0914$ likelihood of being

Division II, and a $21 / 3,600 = 0.0058$ likelihood of being Division III. When adjusting the likelihood to consider the margin of victory, the probability of 1936 Texas being Division I becomes 0.8828 while Division II is now 0.1094 and Division III is now 0.0078.

Returning now to the propagation of trust through the network, the 0.001769 of Division I trust that 1936 Minnesota confers can be properly apportioned to the three division possibilities for 1936 Texas: Division I receives $0.001769 \times 0.8828 = 0.001562$ trust, Division II receives $0.001769 \times 0.1094 = 0.000194$ trust, and Division III receives $0.001769 \times 0.0078 = 0.000014$ trust.

The final mechanism to consider for trust attenuation is the accumulation of trust. Although there are innumerable possibilities to model the accumulation of trust, here it is simply summed into each of a team's respective Division I, Division II, and Division III levels of trust.

Once the first iteration of retaining, splitting, and accumulating trust is completed, it is then repeated using the new trust values for each team to further propagate trust through the network. These iterations are repeated until the network stabilizes, which is when no significant adjustments to the levels of trust can be made with another iteration.

Revisiting the 1936 season, of the 687 teams fielded, 623 received some level of Division I trust from the seed set while the remaining 64 teams were not sufficiently connected to the seed set to receive any. Table 4 shows the top 60 teams from 1936 in terms of Division I trust with their associated Division II and Division III trust shown along with their initial trust. The impact of scheduling, conference affiliations, and previous and subsequent seasons can be easily seen. Of the 49 teams from 1936 in the seed set (e.g., teams that had at least one first, second, or third All-America selection from a major selector), eleven have fallen out of the top 50 teams and been replaced by other teams more tightly connected to the seed set.

One example would be 1936 Virginia Military Institute, who placed Jim Farley as a guard on the New York Sun's All-America second team. Having a selection places 1936 Virginia Military Institute in the seed set with a normalized Division I trust of 0.002841. However, 1936 Virginia Military Institute was sufficiently removed from the other teams in the seed set so that their final accumulated Division I trust was 0.001898, dropping them to 88th overall. Meanwhile, 1936 Southern Methodist, who had no All-America selections in 1936 and so no initial Division I trust, was sufficiently connected to the seed set to accumulate 0.008069 Division I trust, moving them up to 28th overall.

Naturally teams with a higher degree of Division I trust at the end of the propagation are more likely to be considered Division I teams while the next closest are more likely to be Division II and teams furthest from the seed set are more likely to be Division III. Traditionally, thresholds in TrustRank are measured in terms of the trust accumulated. However, the approach used in this study was to approximate the population of Division I, Division II, and Division III using the profile developed from the 1973 to 1977 training set. Table 5 shows the total number of teams and the expected population of each division for each season.

Continuing with the 1936 season and using Table 5, the top 133 teams as measured by Division I trust would be considered Division I while the next 211 teams would be considered Division II and the remainder would be considered Division III.

However, while a good start, the thresholds for each division were still somewhat arbitrarily established, which often becomes obvious when examining the schedules and conference affiliations of specific teams. For example, 1936 Ohio Wesleyan fell above the Division I threshold although seven of their nine opponents, all five of their fellow conference members, and their 1935 instance fell below the Division I threshold. Even with their proximity to the seed set (they played 1936 Pittsburgh), they are clearly more characteristic of a Division II team.

Fortunately, again using data from the 1973 to 1977 training seasons, division probabilities can be determined for each particular team using the divisions assigned by the thresholds. Table 5 shows teams from the 1936 season above the Division I threshold that are more characteristic of a Division II team.

Conversely, teams might fall below the Division I threshold even though they are more characteristic of a Division I team. For example, 1936 Maryland fell below the Division I threshold although six of their eleven opponents, twelve of their fifteen fellow conference members, and both their 1935 and 1937 instances fell above the Division I threshold. Table 6 shows teams from the 1936 season below the Division I threshold that are more characteristic of a Division I team. Note this same condition exists in Division II and Division III as well.

An additional challenge is indecision on part of the classifier when teams exist near the thresholds over a period of seasons where they have a tendency to oscillate between divisions. While this may happen occasionally, the more natural state of teams is to be in one division for a period of seasons.

To address both teams with improbable classifications and the oscillation problem, a “Komondor” algorithm was developed, named after the famed sheepdog. The algorithm seeks to lock teams into each division starting with the ones with highest probability of belonging, much as a group of Komondors representing each division might herd sheep into their respective pens by prioritizing the nearest sheep first. Once all the teams are locked, the algorithm then checks to see if all teams are now in their most probable division as above. If not, the algorithm completes another iteration with the latest classifications now as the starting point. The Komondor algorithm continues until the solution stabilizes.

The Komondor algorithm eventually works all teams into their most probable division while aiding with smoothing, although an additional smoothing routine is performed and the divisions with the lowest frequencies are prioritized above the others to balance the final solution. When complete, every team from every season is identified with its most probable division. Table 7 shows the final list for teams ultimately identified as Division I for 1936. Of interest is that through the Komondor algorithm, two teams listed in Table 5 were eventually retained in Division I while two teams from Table 6 were eventually relegated to Division II.

Results

The classifier produces the results presented in Table 7 for the entirety of 1882 to 1972, with each team being shown with its probability of being Division I, Division II, and Division III, with the division with the highest probability being the “identified” division. Although a comprehensive list of teams and their associated probabilities would be impractical to present, the classifications for each division are given in Appendix A.

From 1946 to 1972, there were 18,223 teams considered. Since only “Major” and “Minor” teams were identified during this period, a Division I classification was considered “major” while a Division II or Division III classification was considered “minor”. Using standard classification terminology, the classifier produced 3,027 true positives, 15,028 true negatives, 62 false positives, and 106 false negatives, for an accuracy of $(3,027 + 15,028) / 18,223 = 99.1\%$. These numbers are presented in a confusion matrix in Table 8.

Table 9 shows the confusion matrix after using the Komondor algorithm to examine the 1973 to 1977 period, which has an accuracy of 91.0%. The classifier performs exceptionally well with Division I but as might be expected has more difficulty in distinguishing between Division II and Division III teams, which is similar to the results found with the naïve Bayesian classifier.

It is important to note that since the initial set of classifications were the actual NCAA classifications, perhaps the performance is not quite as impressive given that the algorithm misidentified approximately 9% of

the teams when given a completely accurate list as the initial input. However, classification for Division II and Division III during this period was achieved through a process of self-determination, so in this instance it might be presumed the greater value of the output is the ability to identify teams that opted for the improper division to begin with. The probabilities suggest there were 245 teams that opted for Division II classification but played schedules characteristic of Division III teams.

Another measure of the classifier is to compare the results to the anecdotal data used to develop the initial seed set, specifically the All-America selections. From 1889 to 1945, there were 2,991 players selected as first, second, or third team All-America by a major selector as identified by Bernie McCarty's exceptional book on the subject, *All-America: The Complete Roster of Football's Heroes Volume One 1889-1945*. Additionally, noted football historian Alexander Weyland retroactively selected 77 players for All-America teams from 1882 to 1888 with the assistance of Yale great Henry Twombly. Of the 3,068 All-America selections, a healthy majority of 2,835 (92.4%) were from teams identified as Division I. An additional 222 (7.2%) were from teams identified as Division II and the final 11 (0.4%) were from teams identified as Division III.

Finally, a comparison to other lists can be made. As highlighted in the previous study, probably the most comprehensive and thoughtful list of teams that could be considered major from 1882 to 1972 has been maintained by James Howell. Howell not only classifies teams from 1869 to the present, but considers major service teams for the WWI and WWII eras. Additionally, Larry Hayes had previously identified major teams with additional corrections provided by Carl Dunn and David Kryszakowski. Since these lists are qualitative rather than quantitative in nature, no attempt is made to measure the efficacy of this classifier against those lists due to the significant difference in approach.

Many of the observations are similar to those initially made in the previous study, specifically the much slower spread of major football to the south and west than other lists account for and the detection of Eastern teams that other lists often overlook. For example, Howell starts most southern teams as major in 1902, whereas this research shows most southern teams should not be considered Division I until 1923. Additionally, Howell and Hayes do not list Gettysburg, Lebanon Valley, Muhlenberg, Susquehanna, or Ursinus as ever fielding teams that could be considered Division I while this research suggests they each fielded teams of that quality for at least two decades in the late 1800s to early 1900s. In fact, perhaps underscoring the dominance of Eastern football, the state of Pennsylvania alone fielded as many as 16 teams Division I quality teams up until the late 1930s. Amazingly, until 1930 even Vermont fielded as many Division I teams as any state outside of the northeast save for California, Texas, and Virginia. Table 10 shows the spread of Division I football by region through the United States plus a column for service teams.

Future Work

Several suggestions for future work were presented in the original paper. Not all of the concepts are repeated in detail so interested readers are encouraged to refer to the original paper.

The first suggestion was to replace the proprietary logistic regression rating system used for the naïve Bayesian classifier with a standard, open sourced rating system. Although several were investigated, in the end any rating system is ultimately an analysis of a network and robust network analysis depends on a robust network. Even today college football is characterized by a relatively sparse network, a problem which only worsens as a researcher works backward toward the sport's origins. A lackluster transportation system and provincial scheduling tendencies and conference affiliations make rating teams from earlier eras difficult without some type of Bayesian inference, which typically complicates a model beyond what would be most likely accepted as a standard, open sourced rating system. Fortunately, this entire dilemma is solved through the adoption of the TrustRank algorithm, which provides a method to quantify the contemporary expertise presented in the form of All-America selections and replace the need for a rating system entirely.

Still, this area might offer opportunities for future possibilities, such as expanding the method used to calculate the initial trust to incorporate bowl participants, polls, and teams sending players to the NFL draft. Originally this approach was used, however it was found the data is widely uneven (i.e., bowls were largely sporadic until the 1930s, the NFL draft did not start until 1935, and polls did not start until 1936) causing the results to be uneven as well. Perhaps this could be revisited in the future with a different weighing of each source for better results.

Also, All-America data itself has not been exhausted. Starting as early as the 1920s, honorable mentions were often selected. However, it might be presumed many of the top players at Division II and Division III equivalent schools were given honorable mention status, so perhaps it could be reasonably assumed an honorable mention during this period would be worth 85% of a point toward Division I trust and 15% toward Division II trust or some other ratio. Another consideration for expansion in this area is the incorporation of All-America teams aimed at smaller schools, such as the Associated Press Little All-America team.

The second suggestion in the original paper was the adoption of an iterative classification procedure. The intent of an iterative classification procedure is to better take advantage of related data. Although in a different form than envisioned in the original paper, the Komondor algorithm is iterative and eventually places teams into their most likely division.

The Komondor algorithm also addresses the “blocking” suggestion from the original paper which was to prevent teams on the fringe of two divisions over several seasons from “fluttering” between them. Note that not all fluttering is eliminated, but any remaining fluttering is due to the actual scheduling practices of a team for a particular season as opposed to being an artifact of indecision on the part of the classifier.

Also suggested in the original paper was the adoption of a “rolling” baseline, so that the 1972 season would be baselined from the 1973 to 1977 data, the 1971 season from the 1972 to 1976 data, 1970 from 1971 to 1975, and so forth. This approach was meant to better accommodate scheduling practices that existed early on, such as the then-common practice of scheduling unlisted teams. Several attempts to incorporate a rolling baseline were done, but with mixed success. Typically, a rolling baseline worked well until 1946, but would dissolve after moving backward into the disruption caused by World War Two. Ultimately, most of the concerns a rolling baselines were aimed at resolving were addressed by assigning the unlisted teams a division in the TrustRank and Komondor algorithms and then filtering them out before the final presentation.

The final suggestion from the original paper was for a method to determine how many classifications might be appropriate for each particular season. Three divisions have been arbitrarily chosen but a clustering algorithm might be able to determine if any particular season is best divided into two, three, four, or more divisions, or perhaps show that no division is necessary. This has not been investigated further although it remains an area for future work.

As before, an effort currently under study that may be presented in future work is an examination the 1973 to 2013 seasons using this same method. The span from 1973 to 1981 represents a period of significant fluctuation in NCAA classifications, particularly from 1978 to 1981 when many schools that initially opted for classification in Division I-A in 1978 struggled to meet the criteria and reverted to Division I-AA in 1982. It is suspected that as many as a third of Division I-A teams from 1978 to 1981 would be more characteristic of a Division I-AA team. Also, an exceptional suggestion from a reader of the original study was to identify which teams might be considered “power conference” quality (“BCS conference”, “major conference”, “AQ conference”, etc.) prior to the origination of the Bowl Championship Series in 1998. Along with the historical perspective offered, of interest is if it can be demonstrated whether the Big East Conference was truly deserving of “power conference” status toward the end of the BCS era and if the Mountain West Conference was deserving of “power conference” status during its strongest era in the mid- to late-2000s.

A final note that bears repeating from the original study is that updates to the score and schedule data along with updates to conference data will almost certainly impact the classifications, at least for Division II and

Division III. New data is provided approximately quarterly and future lists may differ from the one provided in Appendix A although there might be no change in the method.

Recommendation

For the seasons prior to 1946, the recommendation of this study is to adopt the classifications as presented in Appendix A when considering which teams should be considered Division I, Division II, and Division III (or Service I, Service II, and Service III). For the 1946 to 1972 seasons, the NCAA classification of the “major” teams is normally sufficient, although Table 8 shows there are some minor differences that researchers are encouraged to review and consider. However, the recommendation of this study is to adopt the classifications as presented in Appendix A when considering which teams should be considered Division II and Division III during this period.
